### Macmillan Cake Sale

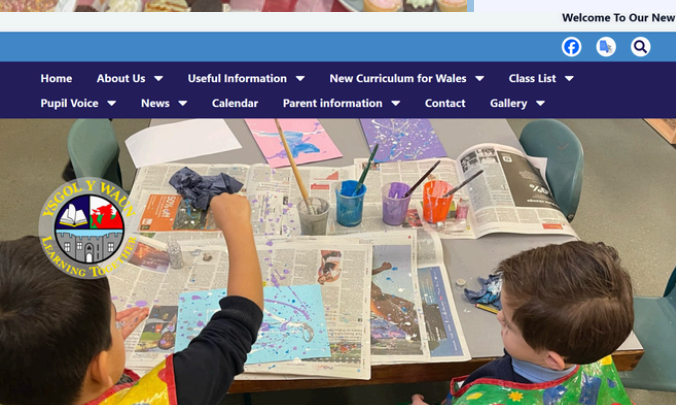
