Macmillan Cake Sale 2026

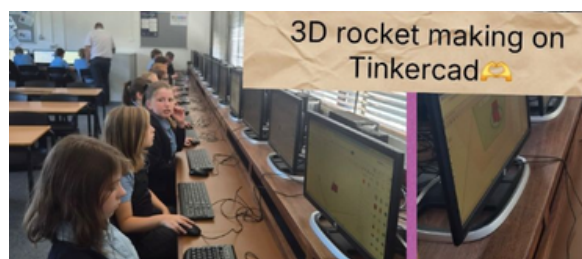
Can we say a big thank you to our school council members who worked their socks off - selling cakes and cups of tea and coffee to parents and members of the community!
