The success of these sessions is largely down to the commitment shown by all staff which includes our teaching assistants, administrators, cleaners, breakfast club workers, kitchen staff and lunchtime supervisers. All staff have fully committed to this new way of working and work hard to ensure sessions are enjoyable and challenging but most of all – safe for the pupils.

We have seen an increase in attendance at school keyworker sessions, we would ask that you make every effort to keep children at home wherever possible as school sessions should only be seen as the final option. If you are working at home then please make every effort to keep your children at home.

COVID-19 infection rates in Wrexham remain extremely high so we need to keep social interactions to a bare minimum.

We all look forward to a time when we can put all this behind us and hope that the current lockdown and the promise of vaccinations in the near future allow this to happen soon.
