



COVID GUIDANCE

Latest guidance received this week requests that pupils who test positive for COVID19 must self-isolate for 7 full days after the day on which they test positive.

If your child has no symptoms on day 8 and the results of two LFD'S are negative on day 6 and day 7 (taken 24 hours apart) they can return to school on day 8.

If your child still tests positive on day 7, they will need to continue their isolation for a full 10 days.

If your child (aged 5 and over) receives a Warn and Inform Letter to say they have been in contact with a positive case they need to carry out LFD tests for 7 days (available from either of the school offices).

If they develop symptoms during this time they need to take a PCR test.
