Dear Parents,

As a community we are all becoming increasingly concerned about the COVID-19 virus and the impact that it is already having on our daily lives.

Our prime minister, Boris Johnson, confirmed last night that schools were to remain open at present.

If pupils develop a 'high temperature' or new 'continuous cough' then parents should keep them at home for 7 days. We have all been advised, should this happen to us, to stay at home and manage our symptoms but not to visit our GP surgery, local pharmacy or local hospital unless the conditions gets worse.

In which case parents can use the NHS 111 online service but to only call 111 if you cannot get help online.

Our government are also advising against public gatherings, with this in mind we have decided to make changes to our Easter Service. This will now take place in school but parents will not be invited to attend. Staff will upload videos of the service to our SEESAW portal to share with parents.

It was our intention to hold parents evening meetings during the final week of term. Parents meetings will now be postponed until further notice.

If you need to speak to a teacher you can still send a 'SEESAW' message or make contact by email/ telephone.

As the days/ weeks progress, we may reach a point where we cannot remain open due to staff shortages. All we can do at this point is to assess our staffing situation on a daily basis.
