## <u>DINNER MONEY – please see letter sent home today</u>

With effect from 5<sup>th</sup> November 2018 there will be a major change to Wrexham County's Dinner payment system. Wrexham school meals are no longer able to allow parents / guardians to run up any debt on school meal accounts and from this date all school meals must be paid for in advance. Please ensure that all accounts are paid up to date and in credit by the above day. School dinners will NOT be provided to pupils whose accounts are in debt and you will need to provide a packed lunch.

### BREAKFAST CLUB - please see letter sent home today

There will also be changes to the Breakfast Club facility with effect from Monday, 5<sup>th</sup> November where there will be a £1.00 charge per day implemented for the first half hour of Breakfast Club (for any drop off between 8 a.m. and 8.30 a.m.) – please note that this charge will not apply to families who are on Free School Meals. ALL payments must be made in advance along with the dates that your child will be attending.

#### THEMED SCHOOOL DINNER

On Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> October, our school meals theme will be Harvest Time when Roast Beef or Roast Quorn will be served along with Yorkshire pudding, mashed potatoes, farmhouse vegetables and gravy followed by fruit crumble and custard. Normal school meal prices apply.
