SCHOOLS ONLINE PAYMENT SYSTEM

A letter has been sent home with your child today regarding the Wrexham On-Line Payment system which allows parents to pay for School Dinners and trips on line. If you wish to use this facility please log on to the website detailed on the letter and follow the Registration process (a flow chart has been included to help guide you through the process).

Alternatively you can continue to make payments using the machines in both reception areas. Payments can be made up to 1pm each day. The payment machines are then emptied by our kitchen staff so that no money is left in them overnight!
