School Start/Finish Times - Changes to Arrangements

School start/ finish times will return to normal from Monday 13th September. Please see below:

CHAPEL LANE

Reception/ Year 1 / Year 2 pupils to arrive at front gate at 8:50 am. A senior member of staff will continue to meet parents/ children at the gate. Nursery parents/pupils to continue walking through the car park, past the canteen, to the Nursery classroom (when dropping off and picking up).

School will now close at 3pm for all Chapel Lane pupils. We ask that Nursery class parents, Maple and Willow Class parents make their way round the back of school to pick up from the classroom door and exit through the central gate out onto Chapel Lane.

We ask that Hazel and Juniper Class parents make their way through the car park and through the gate which leads directly to these classes and exit through the central gate, out onto Chapel Lane.

Y3/ 4/ 5 and 6 pupils to all walk down the main path and to arrive at 8:50 am. A senior member of staff will continue to meet parents/ children by the reception area.

At 3:15 pm we ask that Y3/4 parents walk down the main path to meet their child/ ren - who will be sent out to you when you arrive.

At 3:15 pm Y5/6 pupils will exit school, through the side door, into the front car park area and we would ask that parents wait in this are to meet them.
