

COVID

Changes to self- isolation for household contacts (fully vaccinated and children aged five to 17)

Key messages:

If someone in your household (please also take this into account if you are part of an extended household where your child / children spends part of the week with you and part of the week with another parent) has symptoms of coronavirus or has tested positive:

If you are fully vaccinated or under 18 (with the exception of children aged 0 – 4) - you must self-isolate and take a PCR test. If your test is negative you can stop isolating.

If you are not fully vaccinated and 18 or older - you must self isolate for 10 days. You should get a PCR test on day 2 and day 8 even if these are negative you must continue to isolate for the full 10 days.

If you are a child under 5

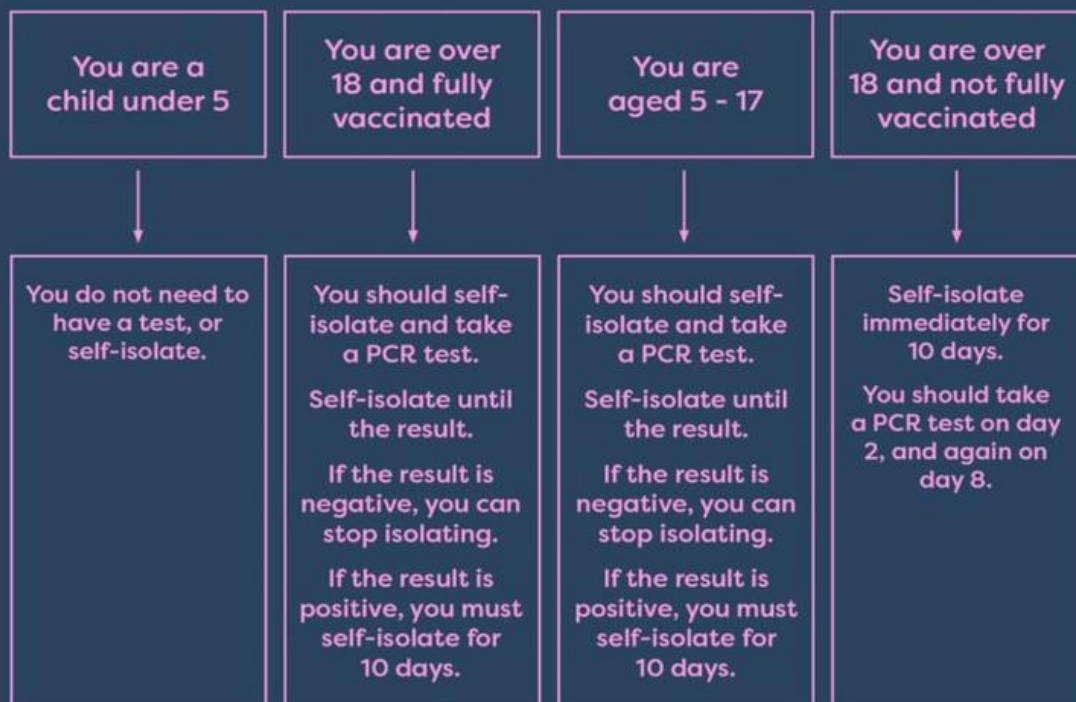
If you are under 5 you do not have to isolate or take a test if you have been a contact of a positive case – household or other.

If a child has tested positive, has come out of isolation and beyond 14 days they become a household contact, they should then be advised to take a LFD test.

Please note that if your child has had covid in the past 90 days, but is within 14 days, no test PCR or LFD is required as long as they are not displaying any new symptoms themselves. If it is over 14 days since they first developed covid symptoms, they should take a LFD test and not return to school until they have had a negative result. PCR tests should be taken if it is more than 90 days since they had their covid infection or a person has developed new core symptoms (cough, fever, loss of taste and/or smell).

The guidance for under 5s has not changed – they are advised not to test and do not need to isolate whether household contact or not unless they develop symptoms themselves and then they should isolate for 10 days.
